

**civil disobedience**

**non-violent refusal to follow a law one believes is unjust, in order to force the government to do or change something**



**grievance**

**a formal complaint about a (real or imaginary) wrong that often leads to action (protest, boycott, etc)**



**militia**

**a group of untrained civilians who fight for a reason/cause**



tyrant

A ruler who abuses their power by using intimidation



boycott

A form of protest in which people will not buy goods or services



intolerable

Something so bad it cannot be accepted or allowed

to cancel a law
